## **Delays continue**

Here's today's Flight Delay Forecast, valid through Sunday, April 6th:

- The front that moved across the Plains and Midwest Wednesday, bringing strong storms across the area, will keep moving eastward over the coming days.
- Thunderstorms are expected from the Southern Plains into the Tennessee Valley Thursday. Delays are expected.
- As the front moves eastward Friday and into the weekend, it will bring rain showers to the East and Northeast and a chance of thunderstorms to the Southeast. Delays are possible.
- The good news is that behind the front, a high-pressure system with improved weather condition will move in.


