## A "spring break" continues

Our Flight Delay Forecast reflects further good weather. This Flight Delay Forecast is valid through Wednesday, April 17th:

- A cold front will push across the Central US to the East Coast Monday through Tuesday, bringing gusty winds and a slight risk of precipitation. Delays are possible but not expected to be significant.
- Behind the cold front, high pressure will move in and good weather and minimal delays are expected.
- The Upper Northwest could see precipitation mid-week, mixed in higher elevations. Delays are possible.


