Weather delays return

Our Flight Delay Forecast the return of rain showers and thunderstorms. This Flight Delay Forecast is valid through Sunday, April 20th:

- A cold front will push across the Mountain States and further across the Central Plains and Midwest over the next few days.
- The front will bring snow showers and wintry precipitation Thursday through Saturday, with delays possible at impacted airports.
- The Central Plains and Midwest will experience rain showers and some areas of thunderstorms Thursday evening through Sunday, with associated delays expected.


