Spring storms on the horizon

A low pressure system will bring rain showers and thunderstorms across much of the country east of the Rockies over the coming days. This Forecast is valid through Sunday, April 27th.

- Rain showers and thunderstorms will impact much of the Central Plains over the next few days. Delays can be expected at impacted airports.
- The system will extend North and East into the upper Midwest, Ohio Valley, and Southeast Friday into Saturday. Delays can be expected, especially at larger airports.
- Clearing will begin across the East Coast Sunday.


