Rain showers across country

Rain showers will blanket much of the country east of the Rockies over the next few days. This Flight Delay Forecast is valid through Sunday, May 4th.

- Rain showers will stretch from the Central Plains to the Upper Midwest and Ohio Valley on Thursday. Strong storms are possible across the South and Ohio Valley later Thursday.
- The Rocky Mountain states will also see precipitation on Thursday, with a chance of frozen precipitation in the higher elevations.
- As the same system moves east, the Midwest will clear up, but the East Coast will experience rain showers and possible thunderstorms in to the weekend, with delays likely, especially at larger hub airports.


