
- Rain showers and thunderstorms will persist across the South, Southeast, Ohio Valley and Northeast on Thursday, resulting in associated delays.
- Storms will move further East, leaving most of the country clear, except the extreme Southeast and Northeast (e.g. EWR) on Friday and Saturday.
- Sunday, most of the country will be experience good weather and few delays, except the extreme Southeast, where the risk of storms will continue.
