## Delays continue, but with some upside

We will continue to experience periodic weather-related delays through the weekend, but the average length of a delay is getting less and less as thunderstorms and rain showers are more concentrated and move across airport corridors more quickly. Relative to winter there are more delays, but they are less severe in <u>duration and impact</u>. Today's Flight Delay Forecast reflects just that, and is valid through Sunday, May 18th.

- Periodic afternoon delays tomorrow and Friday along the East Coast
- **Midwest** impacted by short, periodic delays on Friday
- Weekend generally good, with a few delays across the Central and Mountain states


